Guidelines for a Code of Conduct in Internationalisation

What do we expect from host families?

- Providing a comfortable place to stay, breakfast, a packed lunch if necessary.
- Providing transport to and from School, or from the meeting places.
- Getting in touch with their student's teachers, if the student does not observe the rules agreed on.
- Getting in touch with a student's teacher if he or she needs to visit a doctor.
- Accepting responsibility for the safety and well-being of their guest.

What do we expect from host students?

- Anyone joining an international exchange must be willing to receive a foreign guest, and vice versa.
- Feeling responsible for the well-being of his or her guest.
- Using English (and German!) as the official language for the week, when the student is in the presence of a guest.
- Getting in touch with the accompanying teacher in case of a problem.
- Providing to be in time at an appointed time and place.
- Taking care that on weekdays and outside school activities, the host and his or her guest will be at home by 11,00 p.m. at the latest.
- Abstaining from drinking alcoholic drinks and avoiding any contact with drugs and any places where these can be used or bought.

- Fully taking part in and doing their very best during the Workshops at school and in the exchange week in general.
- Contributing to creating a pleasant atmosphere during visits.
- Realising that, if students misbehave seriously (which we do not expect), the accompanying teachers reserve the right to send a student back to his or her country at the expense of their parents.

What do we expect from guest students?

- Behaving properly and showing respect for a host family's hospitality.
- Keeping to appointments, as time for getting up in the morning, dinnertime, come back home in time.
- Being willing to adapt themselves to some changes of customs, which a different culture involves.
- Getting in touch with the accompanying teacher in case of a problem.
- Abstaining from drinking alcoholics and avoiding any contact with drugs and any places where they are used or bought.
- Not going out without their host family's permission: family rules will also be host student's rules.
